EGGY FACES

A fun and kinaesthetic dictation exercise, painting faces onto real (or fake) eggs. Great for recycling language related to faces, facial expressions and feelings.



EGG HUNTS

Hide Easter- or Spring-related vocabulary / quiz questions in plastic eggs around your classroom. Some great extension tasks include: story-writing, grammar and conversational practice.



EASTER QUIZ!

Start or finish your class with a quiz on vocabulary, meaning, grammar forms, knowledge.



JOKES

Find some great Spring / Easter jokes to read and tell, and have learners making their own to tell each other.



EASTER RHYMES

Spring and Easter poems and rhymes are a fun way to practise pronunciation. Use TPR for a kinaesthetic element.
